

Remote Desktop Report

PLATFORM FEATURE UPDATE

Adlumin users now have access to a **Remote Desktop Report**, which provides an overview of remote desktop access events (e.g., logins, logoffs, meta data, etc.). Specifically, this new report shows the top accounts that are using Remote Desktop to access another computer or system on the network. The report shows the last **50 remote desktop events** that occurred on the platform during a specific date and time range.

Users can download the report (PDF) in seconds, or schedule and deliver a copy directly to their inbox (e.g., weekly, monthly, quarterly).

This report is located under *Reports > Executive Reports > Additional Executive Reports*.
